



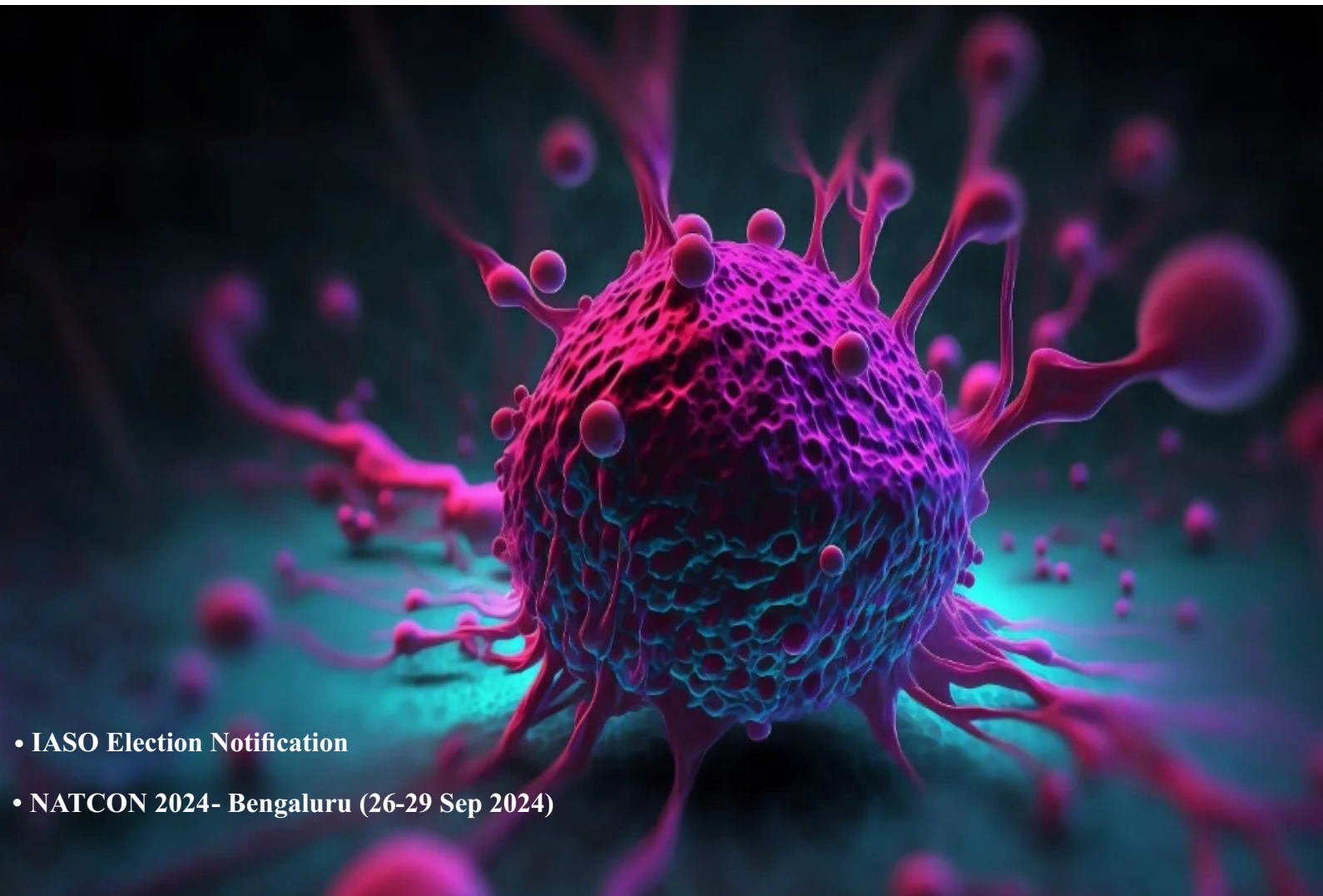

Dear IASO members

Cancer patients diagnosed with cancer in India per year is reaching to almost fifteen lakh new cases per year and more than half of these patients are dying of cancer sooner or later. Non- uniformity of treating facilities across the country making it difficult for cancer control. Canceronomics is a big challenge today with high rise of treatment cost and affordability disparity. Most of these cancers are solid tumors and cancer surgery is an integral part of the treatment and contributes significantly to the survival of the patient as R0 resection only way to achieve the desired outcome.

India is vast country with variable treatment facility at first second and tier three cities. For the country at large, proper training in cancer surgery and availability of trained man power in cancer surgery are real needs of the hour with growing armamentarium like laparoscopic / robotic cancer surgery. At present per year nearly 350 new cancer surgeons are getting trained all across India. There are many hinderances in uniformity in training across country unable to give a backup bench strength for cancer control.

This includes issues like uneven distribution of the training facilities in the country, non- uniformity of training modules across various institutions, lacunae in skill and knowledge updation of the practicing surgical oncologists and lack of job opportunity for passing out cancer surgeons. Leaders in oncology heading various major institutes, many are members in committees deciding the curriculum of medical education and public health care in the country and many are involved in training a large number of surgeons in Surgical Oncology. I strongly feel that it is the responsibility of IASO is to act as conduit between these leaders who are also international stalwarts in surgical oncology, to young budding onco -surgeons and use their collective opinions, power and actions to create better environment for the younger onco-surgeons and cancer surgery in the country.

IASO now with the vibrant leadership is growing well and spreading its wing across India and abroad, by its efforts and also collaborating with many national and international associations like SSO ESSO BASO Brazil SO society.

Notification for Election of IASO office bearers ,2024

President and Secretary of IASO hereby notifies Elections for IASO 2024 for the following posts.

Eligibility for IASO Posts

1) Vice President -A full member of IASO who has completed 10 years as full life member (up to 31st July of the year of applying) and has served at least one term as an elected/nominated Executive member is eligible to contest for the post of Vice President.

2) Executive Committee Member - Candidates who have put in a minimum 5 year full life membership of IASO till 31st July of the year of applying for the Executive committee are eligible to apply for Executive Committee member post.

Any office bearer/ EC member should complete his term before taking over another assignment.

Application Process: Every Nominaton shall **be proposed and seconded** by two full members of IASO. One member can propose or second only one candidate. Candidate should submit following signed documents

- 1. Nomination form (Format Enclosed)**
- 2. Brief Biodata as per format given below**

At the time of sending he nomination the candidate should send the following information's -

- He/she should send a brief summary of his/her achievements (a brief background about his achievements and contributions - publications, conference organized, scientific contribution etc.), contribution to IASO and Bio -data (with Photo), all this not exceeding 250 words and signed by him/her. This should also have a mention of IASO conferences attended in last 5 years. This information will be put forward to the members before and during the online voting.

Invalid Nomination: If the nomination is found invalid the candidate will be informed about the same and the reason for invalidity mentioned. The nomination that are received in time will be scrutinized by the Election Committee comprising of President, President Elect, & Vice president.

Withdrawal of Nomination: The candidates can withdraw their nominations latest by **05th September 2024, 5:00 PM** through the same email iasosecretariat@gmail.com with copy to President (svsdeo@gmail.com) President elect (drsharaddesai@gmail.com) and Vice President (subramanyesh@gmail.com)

Election Process and Voting The elections will be conducted under the overall supervision of Election committee comprising of President, President Elect, & Vice president. The Secretary will guide the election process and the **President Elect (Dr Sharad Desai) will be the Returning Officer.**

Election will be conducted online as decided by Google survey opinion, EC meetings and General Body meeting approval obtained during 2022, The online voting will be by a vendor chosen by the Election committee after approval of active EC members.

Cut date for eligibility to vote . Full life Members who have been inducted as new members. till 31st July of the election are eligible to vote for current year.

Organ-based symposium & live hands-on workshop on Gastric Cancer conducted at AIIMS Jodhpur

The Department of Surgical Oncology at AIIMS Jodhpur, in association with the Indian Association of Surgical Oncology (IASO), conducted an organ-based symposium & live hands-on workshop on 16th & 17th of February 2024, spearheaded by Dr. Shailesh Shrikhande, Deputy director at TATA Memorial Hospital Mumbai, Professor & head, Division of Cancer Surgery & Chief Gastrointestinal & HPB services at TATA Memorial Centre & a man of many accolades.

The theme of the Symposium was D2 Gastrectomy and Whipple's procedure, which spanned over two days. 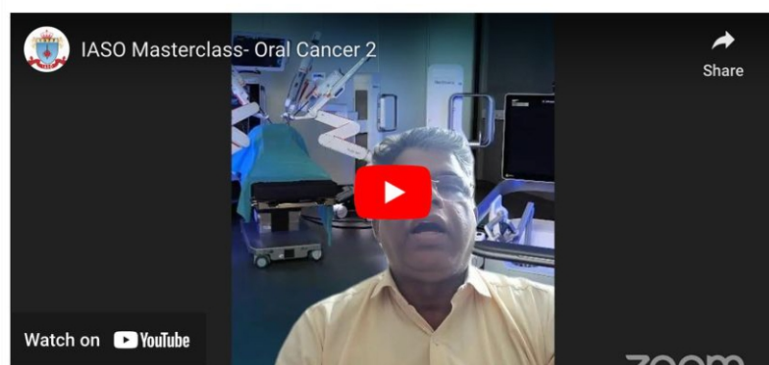

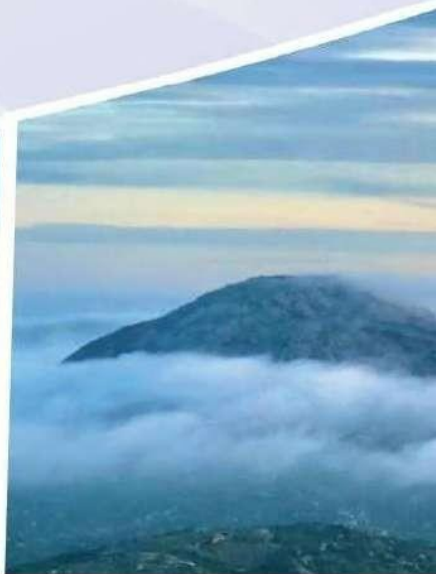
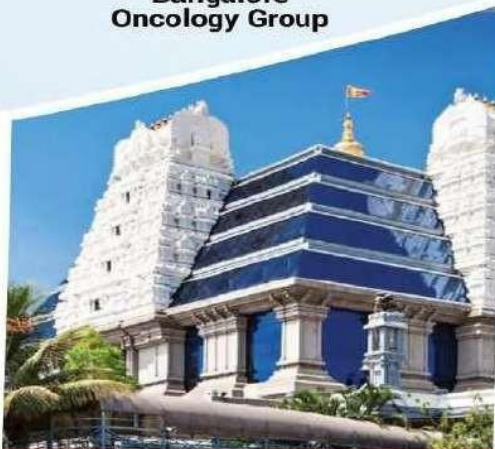
